Shade, Shelter & Space!



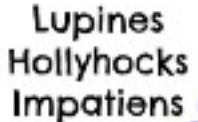
Herbs, flowering shrubs, dwarf trees, and vines all create an ideal tiered habitat. Provide a lot of space between plants so they have room to hover and navigate between flowers.
